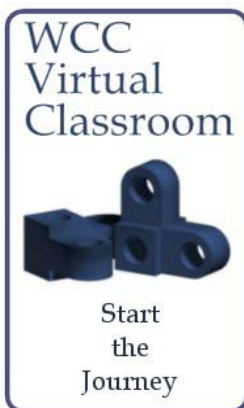

WCC Web Design Book!

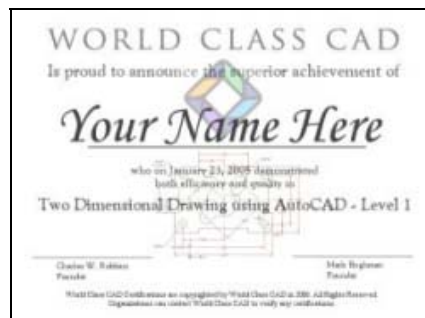
A new book is going on the World Class CAD website and this text
