
Adding Weather to your Website

Open AccuWeather.com Homepage


Open the Accuweather.com homepage.

On the Spry toolbar, we select Community and then download.



Free Weather on your Site


Under the Weather Widgets and Downloads, we select Free Weather for your Site or Blog.



Start the Three Step Process Here

There are multiple styles of weather reports for us to choose.

We then select the Get My Netweather Button.




Step 1 – Scale, Language and Location

In the first step, we choose whether we want Celsius or Fahrenheit scale, the language, and the zip code.

We press the Search button and the zip code in the textbox will change to the metropolitan area.


We then press the Next button.



Step 2 - Select Size, Category and Color


In the second step, we choose the size of the weather report, the category or style and lastly the theme or color.

The size of the weather report is important if we are fitting their popup into a certain space.



Step 3 – Agreement and Code

In the third step, we check the I agree checkbox and the code textboxes will appear.




The AccuWeather Code


Paste the Program in the Dreamweaver Code

We place our mouse in the webpage where you want the weather report and switch to the Code view. We paste the program into our HTML code. When we return to the Design view, the outline of the weather report is visible.
