


Turn off ICS on Window Server 2008


External NIC

To turn off Internet Connection Sharing (ICS), we open the External NIC on the Network Connection window. We then click on the Properties button.




Turn off ICS

Select the Sharing tab on the External NIC window and uncheck the ICS checkbox. Press the OK button and close all the windows to save the changes.



ICS Services

Go to Administrative Tools and select Services. In the Services window, we choose Internet Connection Service (ICS).



Disable ICS

Change the Startup type to Disabled and press OK.

We now can setup the Windows 2008 Server for Network Address Translation.
