Why Remote Installation?


In previous lessons, we manually placed the Windows disc in the CD ROM player and manually installed the operating system.

This is the beginning of a process to add another valuable server, the Remote Installation Server (RIS) to our list of machines to build and deploy.




Open Add or Remove Programs

We open the Start menu and pick the Control Panel. We select the Add or Remove Programs icon and then we pick Add / Remove Windows Components.




Windows Components Wizard

When the Add / Remove Windows Components dialogue box appears, we annotate the Windows Deployment Services checkbox and press the Next button to continue.



Configuring Components

When we configure the components for the RIS services, we will need to insert the server operating system disc in the CDROM.



Completing the Wizard

We will restart the server after pressing the Finish button.

The next lesson will have us install a copy of the operating system on a clean partition in the RIS server.
